

Today you have a lot of "Aids" to help us in "fishing" In our study we have discussed the more important ones, but in the final analysis (with all these aids), it comes down to Presentation of Lures, as to wheather we put fish on the stringer.

It has been pointed out; in order to have fishing success you and I must be fishing in the right place at the right time and in the right manner. This means exactly what it says - FISHING, and this means PRESENTATION of LURES. We could have all the aids, and all the knowledge, but if we fail on the Presentation of Lures, these things aren't worth very much. BUT, if we didn't have the knowledge or the proper aids, we couldn't do a very good job of Presentation of Lures.

Fishing can be bad and it usually is, and if you and I don't exercise discipline in our presentation, we are not likely to succeed very often. We must fish in the right manner so as to be at the right place at the right time as fast as possible and as often as possible.

This means we must go about our fishing in an orderly and precise manner. Not haphazardly!
